In May 2007 we received a confirmation letter from the Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency in Brussels concerning the progress report of ENOTHE.

Their comment on the progress report is as follows:

“The project activities are progressing successfully. It seems to be well organised thanks to the experience of the partners working in the network. However it is important to take into consideration the following recommendations...”

One of these recommendations is:

“It would be a good dissemination tool to provide more information about the ENOTHE network on the websites of the partners and add links to it.”

The EC recommended this already one year ago of which we informed all members by mail and orally in the general assembly, however after control still many members have not made visible their link to ENOTHE.

We kindly request you to check if the link on the website of your institute is (still) available, or otherwise ask your webmaster to make the link in order to avoid new comments from the EC on this issue.

Furthermore we like to remind you that soon a period of new projects is starting for which the deadline is the **1<sup>st</sup> of July**. We encourage many of you to develop joint European projects. You can find the project outline on the website.

We like to inform you that ENOTHE has applied for a ENOTHE MUNDUS network for the next study year in order to consider our network in a global perspective, to compare the specific competences in different parts of the world and to advance the research agenda in occupational science. (more information will follow in the Cork meeting and as soon as the application is approved)

22 institutions from all parts of the world (Australia, Canada, USA, Japan, Caucasus and Africa), have signed this application.

Lastly we like to remind you to send in your registration form before the **1<sup>st</sup> of July** for the low registration fee.
