

## Academic calendar

**2023/2024**

(Approved by UDC Council Government on 30th March 2023)

### 1. ACADEMIC COURSE

The academic course 2023/2024 will run from 11<sup>th</sup> September 2023 to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2024. The course will be divided into two terms, according to point 2. There will not be academic activities in August, as well as on public holidays and evaluation periods.

Students evaluated in the second opportunity of Internships/TFM\*/TFG\*, whose registers are signed on 30<sup>th</sup> September, will be considered students in the academic year 2023/2024.

### 2. ACADEMIC PERIODS

Teaching periods are divided into two terms:

**First term:** from 11<sup>th</sup> September to 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2023

**Second term:** from 29<sup>th</sup> January to 10<sup>th</sup> May 2024

Master courses, as far as they do not need the established evaluation period in the table below, can start teaching activities in October and continue until 26<sup>th</sup> January. In this case, the second term can start one week later. The Master coordinators have to inform the Academic Organization Service in case they choose this option.

### 3. EXAMINATION PERIODS

Bachelor/Master students will be entitled to two evaluation opportunities each academic year and examination calendar will be organized as follows:

Students enrolled in internships/TFG/TFM with individualized records will have two opportunities each academic course according to the calendar below:

TFG/TFM enrolment and defence will have to fulfil with the articles 1, 2 and 3 of the Regulation on TFG/TFM enrolment and defence, passed by UDC Government Council on 19/12/2013 and the subsequent modifications.

Academic teaching activities, as well as exams, will be interrupted on 7<sup>th</sup> December (closing of centres, buildings and university installations according to the Resolution relative to the measures of energy saving and reduction of the environmental impact), from 26<sup>th</sup> December 2023 to 5<sup>th</sup> January 2024 (both included), as well as on 12-13<sup>th</sup> February 2024, from 25<sup>th</sup> March to 1<sup>st</sup> April 2024 (both included). Also, there will not be academic teaching activities on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2023 for being the University Day. Likewise, the academic teaching activities will be suspended on local, autonomous, regional and national holidays and also on the day each Faculty/School mark their own holiday.

In order to optimise the teaching periods as much as possible, University holidays taking place on Tuesday/Thursday will be changed to nearest Monday/Friday, respectively; those taking place on Wednesday will be changed to Friday. Those taking place on Saturday, Sunday or holidays will be changed to the previous/following working day.
