

A. How to find the works of the recommended bibliography of a subject of study in the *Crunia* catalogue?

The best way to find the recommended bibliography for a subject of study in *Crunia* is by clicking on the 'Recommended bibliography' button in the top menu.



We will go to the specific search engine of the recommended bibliography.




In it we will choose the degree and then a search box will appear where we will select the subject of study. Finally, click on "Search".





A new screen opens, at the top of which are the boxes from the advanced search we have just carried out, at the bottom of which is a list of all the recommended titles of that subject that appear in *Crunia*, in this case there are 6.



Important note when reviewing the recommended bibliography:

Normally *Crunia* lists as 'recommended bibliography' the most modern edition of the title available in the library. If an electronic edition is available, this will also appear in the 'recommended bibliography' list. Sometimes the different editions of a work are grouped together.
