

## STATEMENT on pseudoscience

- 1. The Ethics Committee for Research and Teaching at the University of A Coruña (CEID-UDC) is a collegiate, interdisciplinary, independent and advisory university body whose purpose is to evaluate and ensure the ethical correctness of research and teaching and to promote scientific and academic integrity at the University of A Coruña (UDC).
- 2. The University of A Coruña is responsible for the development, transmission and critique of science, technology and culture.
- 3. In exercising this function, the University of A Coruña will defend academic freedom and autonomy and promote quality in the performance of its activities.
- 4. Academic freedom, freedom of research, freedom of expression and the absence of prior censorship are guarantees of research, teaching and dissemination at the University of A Coruña.

- 5. Pseudoscience involves the transmission or dissemination of knowledge that is presented as scientific without being based on scientific arguments, criteria or methods.
- 6. Pseudoscience is ethically incorrect because it undermines two basic values in the pursuit of knowledge: truth and trust.
- 7. Pseudoscience damages scientific and academic integrity because it fails to meet two requirements of responsible research and teaching: rigour and honesty.

8. For the reasons set out above, the UDC's Research and Teaching Ethics Committee rejects pseudoscience and concludes that the University of A Coruña must guarantee scientific and academic integrity in all activities that make use of its name, image or facilities.
